## Course Description:

Welcome to your $8^{\text {th }}$ grade math class, Algebra I. This course is comparable to the Algebra I class offered at Milford High School. It will deal with math topics in a more general, broad, application-based approach. Topics include: Number Sets, Variables, Properties of Real Numbers, Linear Equations, Functions, Relations, Quadratics, Polynomials and Graphs. These topics will provide you with some of the most important mathematical skills you will need in life as well as help to create a strong foundation for your future math classes.

## Materials:

- Textbook: Algebra 1: Common Core; Charles, et al.; Pearson Educational, Inc.; ©2012 (can be kept home)
- 3-ring binder with dividers or a 2-subject (at least) notebook that you use just for math!
- Calculator - a scientific or graphing calculator is recommended
- Pencils - You may take notes in pen, however, your homework, classwork, tests/quizzes should be completed in pencil.
- Ruler
